Grant Spotlight: Teachers Pay Teachers

With access to thousands of resources ready for digital download or printing, Teachers Pay Teachers is the largest online resource and educational marketplace for teachers. Teachers Pay Teachers was a crucial tool for educators when the pandemic hit and technology played a front role in accessing lessons for students. WEST paid for a \$6,000 credit toward TpT so our teachers could access material they needed without reaching into their own pockets. Lessons for our children continued seamlessly and new material was shared throughout this school year. Children in pre-K through grade 6 were able to benefit from the resources our teachers found.

Art Grants



When schools shut down last spring due to the pandemic, Delaney's art teacher, Mrs. Krista Langley-Haner, applied for a WEST grant to get proper art materials in the hands of students who didn't have them at home and would typically count on having fun with these materials in the art room. With this grant 50 at-home art kits were created.



Ralph Masiello's 1-hour presentation introduced to first graders the process that published author/illustrators use to produce a book. He stressed reading and research skills, and shared his drawing strategies as the children drew with him. In doing so we hope to motivate and encourage the children to be interested in writing/illustrating their own stories!



Mad Scientist Grant



The Mad Scientist performance sparks the imagination by professional instructors equipped with highly-cool gear to deliver unique, hands-on science experiences to Wrentham's 6th-grade students. The "Don't Try This At Home" program has students conducting experiments such as creating an electrical circuit with the audience's bodies, creating a tiny lightning storm, changing water's temperature instantly, seeing how a rainbow is made, floating on a Mad Science hovercraft, building super bouncy balls and so much more!
